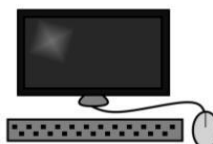

the May 9th meeting***

1. Treasurer's Report – Marlene distributed a 2-page report for the month of April. Total General Fund Receipts were \$7,682.08. Expenses for the month totaled \$6,987.23. Joyful Noise offerings for Ukraine relief totaled \$501.59. The piano was tuned at a cost of \$145.00. \$500 was collected during the month for Ralla Roth. As a review, Zook's Meat Pie Fundraiser net income was \$789.00 and Vince's Steak Sandwiches netted \$435.00.

Endowment Fund - \$256,395.00

Moritz Fund – \$16,478.00

Memorial Savings Account – \$7,584.78

Capital Savings Account – \$10,496.56

2. Pastor's Report– Pastor Janet read a passage from Ecclesiastics. She expressed her concerns regarding her position here at St. John's after her meetings with Mark and the Pastoral Relations Committee. Her possible half time position with Greenawalds was also discussed. Three things were decided following a lengthy discussion with the pastor and Consistory members. A suggestion box could be placed in the narthex where members could express their concerns and/or things that they like, as not everyone is comfortable with a face-to-face dialog. The Pastoral Relations Committee should have regular meetings. There should be an employee meeting.

3. Old Business -

a. Revised Breakfast Schedule–Except for special occasions like Easter and Mother's Day, the monthly breakfast will be discontinued for now.

b. Bake Sale –The Confirmation bake sale netted \$550.00. Thank you to everyone who contributed.

c. Front door locking procedure/solution—The front door has been found to be unlocked upon arriving at the church on multiple occasions. When you leave, please check from the outside that the door is locked. Jeff will check with the locksmith to see if there is an easier way to ensure locking.

4. New Business -

a. Vince's Fundraiser on Thursday – Vince's will once again be at Mark's garage this Thursday, May 12.

b. Memorial Day Service—Pastor Janet will talk to Pastor Nelson about plans for the VFW and Boy Scouts. Marilyn Roth and Ray Huber should also be consulted.

c. Schedule of upcoming events—Pastor Janet told us that her daughter Grace is being confirmed on June 5 at her church. She would like to be able to attend. We will work to possibly start services earlier here on that date so that she will be able to get to the confirmation.

June 12 – Roger Snyder will be here on that Sunday to celebrate the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of his ordination. We could possibly have a luncheon that day. Roger is Christine Dietrich's son.
